WHEREAS, Every year hundreds of lives are lost in boating accidents. These fatalities can be reduced and boating made more pleasurable if those who engage in it will emphasize the knowledge, care, and understand the value of having and wearing Life Jackets because responsible boaters understand that LIFE JACKETS SAVE LIVES AND THEY WON'T WORK IF YOU DON'T WEAR THEM; and

WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States, having recognized the need for such emphasis, has by Joint Resolution requested the President to annually proclaim one week as National Safe Boating Week; and

WHEREAS, President Bill Clinton has proclaimed the week of May 20-27 as "NATIONAL SAFE BOATING WEEK",
