1. Mayor Miller called the meeting to order at 6:36pm
2. Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Spahlinger.
3. Roll Call ; Mayor Miller, Mayor Pro-Tem Spahlinger, Councilwoman Hanson, Councilman Haag, Councilman Rottino were present. Councilman Barnett joined the meeting via zoom @ 6:38pm. Quorum was established with Mayor Miller presiding.
4. Citizen Comments: Citizens wishing to speak must sign up to do so (3 Minute Maximum)

5. Discuss and take action on a request for a Building Code Variance for Cap City Storage, located at 12332 ST Hwy 198 Payne Springs, TX 75156.

Councilman Rottino made a motion for a variance for Cap City Storage, for the plans not to require Engineered Licensed seal is required on the foundation, structure, electrical, plumbing and ground grade as presented by Safebuilt, only on two buildings being built now, does not include the third building, seconded by Councilman Haag. Motion carried 5/0.

Councilwoman Hanson made a motion for a variance for Cap City Storage, not requiring a fire sprinkler system only on two buildings being built now, does not include the third building, seconded by Councilman Haag. Motion carried 4/1, Councilman Rottino was against.

Should any final action, final decision or final vote be required in the opinion of the City Council with regard to any matter considered in such executive session, then the final action, final decision or final vote shall be in the open meeting covered by this Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting.

"Pursuant to Texas Government Code section 551.007, members of the public may speak on an agenda item during the citizens comment section of the meeting or at the time the agenda item is called for discussion by the Mayor. Speakers must sign up with the City Secretary to speak and shall be given three (3) minutes to speak. A speaker needing a translator and/or interpreter may be given six (6) minutes to speak. Criticism of city employees or staff is prohibited. Those wishing to

address the Council regarding an item not on the agenda must be a citizen, property owner or business owner of Payne Springs. Comments on such non-agenda items shall be limited to three minutes. The Council will not comment on items not on the agenda; however, the Council may refer the item to city staff for research, resolution or referral of the matter to the Council as a future agenda item.”
