

ORDINANCE NO. 25 MINUTES OF NOV. 30, 1993 COUNCIL

NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION FOR LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX, FIXING THE DATE OF ELECTION, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES, APPOINTING PRESIDING JUDGE AND ASSISTANT PRESIDING JUDGES AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE TO BE GIVEN OF THE ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PAYNE SPRINGS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. THAT AN ELECTION BE ORDERED IN SAID CITY ON THE QUESTION OF THE ADOPTION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX FOR THE BENEFIT OF SAID CITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF HOUSE BILL NO. 207, 60TH LEGISLATURE, REGULAR SESSION, 1967, P. 62, CH 36, EFFECTIVE AUGUST 28TH 1967.

SECTION 2. THAT AN ELECTION BE ORDERED IN SAID CITY ON THE 15 DAY OF JAN, WHICH DATE IS NOT LESS THAN (30) NOR MORE THAN (90) DAYS AFTER THE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. AND 8:00 P.M.

SECTION 3. SAID ELECTION SHALL BE HELD IN THE PAYNE SPRINGS COMMUNITY CENTER SITUATED ON 198S. IN PAYNE SPRINGS CITY, HENDERSON COUNTY, TEXAS, AND MAE PEARL McLAUGHLIN IS HEREBY APPOINTED PRESIDING JUDGE, AND JO ANN WALKER IS HEREBY APPOINTED ALTERNATE PRESIDING JUDGE, AND THEY SHALL APPOINT SUCH NUMBER OF ASSISTANT JUDGES AND ELECTION CLERKS AS THEY DEEM NECESSARY.

SECTION 4. THAT LOUISE BYERS, IS HEREBY APPOINTED ELECTION JUDGE OF THE ABSENTEE BALLOTING, WHICH SHALL BE HELD AT HER HOME ON DOUBLE BRIDGE RD. AND IS HEREBY GIVEN THE AUTHORITY TO APPOINT AS MANY ASSISTANT ELECTION JUDGES FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTING AS MAY DEEM PROPER.

SECTION 5. BALLOTS OF SAID ELECTION SHALL HAVE WRITTEN OR PRINTED THEREON THE FOLLOWING:

"FOR ADOPTION OF A ONE PER CENT (1%) LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY."

"AGAINST ADOPTION OF A ONE PER CENT (1%) LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY."

EACH VOTER SHALL MARK OUT ONE OF THE ABOVE PROPOSITIONS SO THAT THE ONE REMAINING SHALL INDICATE THE WAY HE WISHES TO VOTE.

THE MANNER OF HOLDING SAID ELECTION SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED HOUSE BILL NO. 207, WHICH IS THE SAME AS ARTICLE 1066c. LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX ACT, PART OF TITLE 28 OF THE REVISED CIVIL STATUTES OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW APPLICABLE TO OTHER MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.

SECTION 6. IN THE EVENT SAID 1% LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE BY A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORATE OF PAYNE SPRINGS CITY, TEXAS, THEN ALL SAID FUNDS SO RECEIVED FROM SAID TAX SHALL BE PLACED IN THE GENERAL FUND OF SAID CITY.

SECTION 7. NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION SHALL BE GIVEN BY PUBLISHING A SUBSTANTIAL COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE ON THE SAME DAY OF TWO SUCCESSIVE WEEKS IN A NEWS PAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE CITY. THE DATE OF THE FIRST PUBLICATION TO BE AT LEAST TWENTY ONE (21) DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE SET FOR ELECTION. THE CITY SECRETARY IS HEREBY INSTRUCTED TO CAUSE SAID NOTICE TO BE SO GIVEN.
